

5. The East Kettering Liaison Forum

Kettering Borough Council recognises the significance of the proposed development of the urban extension to the East of Kettering and local concerns about its implementation and its impact on the local environment. The Council wants to facilitate communication between all the stakeholders in the locality affected so that accurate information is available to all parties and any concerns can be raised and discussed. As well as the Council's interest in representing local people and as a custodian of the economic, environmental and social well being of the Borough, it is also the local planning authority. As the decision-maker for applications for the development of the urban extension, the Council must ensure that applications are considered in accordance with statutory requirements and its own rigorous ethical standards. The Forum cannot be part of this decision making process and formal arrangements are necessary to demonstrate this separation in the roles the Council performs.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

- To provide a channel of communication between public agencies
 and those communities most affected by the development of East
 Kettering
- To provide a sounding board for issues arising from planning and design, infrastructure provision, housing delivery and democratic representation, in order to secure a sustainable, quality development which improves the quality of life of local people
- To allow communities and developers to communicate directly
- To monitor the implementation and impact of the development on the economic, environmental and social well being of the area.

Observer status to be accorded to KBC Planning Committee Chair. If the Planning Committee Chair is a member of the Forum they shall be entitled to observer status only.

Parish Councils and Community Groups may appoint any person as their representative, unless that person is already entitled to attend.

Members will receive all agendas, minutes and other papers. If invited to contribute to meetings by the Chair, they will not be constrained by the Right to Speak policy. In the event that a vote is required, it will be conducted by show of hands.

The Forum shall elect an elected Member of the Council as Chair and a Deputy Chair at its first meeting and thereafter at the first meeting in each municipal year.

The Forum, or the Chair on behalf of the Forum, may invite representatives of other bodies to its meetings as advisers to discuss matters in which they are concerned or have expertise. Representatives of residents will be invited to join the Forum as the development becomes occupied.

The Forum shall be advised and supported by officers of the Borough Council, and other agencies as appropriate.

MEETINGS

Meetings shall <u>normally</u>, be held every 2 months <u>unless determined</u> <u>otherwise</u>. Meetings will be held at the offices of Kettering Borough

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Council until facilities are available in the new development. An agenda shall be sent to members five clear working days before any meeting. The members of the Forum shall be as open as possible with each other and seek to enhance public knowledge about the development. They shall, however, respect the justifiable confidentiality of information they acquire, for example on protected species or contractual matters. Members shall clearly state any request for confidentiality and the grounds on which it is sought. Meetings of the Forum will be in public, unless decided otherwise for specified items. The Council shall publish the minutes of meetings.

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Conduct of Meetings

There will be a clear agenda, brief, action-focused minutes and participation opportunities around questions of design and delivery.
