Dear Sir or Madam.

I am writing to you with reference for about the application for a premises licence (section 17) applied for by U-BAHN/ROBERTS at the premises of KETTERING Railway Station, STATION ROAD, KETTERING, NN15 7HJ.

I feel that a licence should not be granted on the ground that, as there are two home for senior citizen's accommodation in the near vicinity of which I have a relative living who's window face the road, and is feeling apprehensive about this application, as she remembers the last time that a club was at the station and people would go into the bushes in front of her window to urinate.

Also as this is now becoming a more residential area with old office blocks two flats

with the police mainly concentrate in Kettering town centre at the weekend. if there is any trouble at the station the response it will not be a rapid one.

As there is also only one member of station staff on in the evening's and the station closes early on Saturdays & Sunday there would be no person to phone the police or watch to see what is occurring

as this is now a quite road the noise will ~~not~~ increase.

When you look around Kettering town Centre very early morning with the litter, broken bottles, pulled out flower beds, which the council clear up on a daily bases, will they go down station road to clean this area up, there only empty the litter bins once a week.

Also parking is not free at the station so people will park on the street which is already full of car and Network rail vans at weekend and weekdays

The premises if I remember from going in year ago when it was a bar has very few toilet one cubicle each, and as the site is run by a private company, there would be no fire escape for the basement premises.
