## **Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions**

**If this premises licence authorises the sale by retail or supply of alcohol to members or guests:-**

1. The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relations to the premises.
2. In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children-
  - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to-
    - i. drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol) or
    - ii. drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
  - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
  - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
  - (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on-
    - i. the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
    - ii. the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
  - (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
3. The responsible person shall ensure no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
4. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

5. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence at times when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence or at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his/her personal licence is suspended.
6. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence
7. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
8. The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
9. The responsible person shall ensure that –
  - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-
    - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint
    - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25ml or 35ml; and
    - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125ml; and
  - (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

**If this premises licence authorises the exhibition of films:-**

10. Admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by the British Board of Film Classification.

**If this premises licence details the use of door supervisors:-**

11. All persons employed as door supervisors must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

## **Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the operating schedule**

An operational plan will be in place which incorporates the licensing objectives.

The premises will be a member of a pubwatch scheme where such a scheme exists.

Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

When amplified musical entertainment is provided, doors and secondary glazed windows will be kept shut, save for entrance and exit purposes.

Staff will check the exterior of premises regularly to ensure that noise levels are not sufficient to cause problems to neighbouring properties

The external area will be kept clean and tidy.

1. Written records shall be kept in respect of all incidents that occur both inside and at the point of entry to the premises. These records shall be sequentially numbered and kept in a form that would prevent any form of tampering. These records must be made immediately available to Police or local authority officers on request.
2. Door supervisors will be in place at the discretion of the operator, when utilised there will be two supervisors for the first 100 occupants and an additional supervisor for any occupants over 100. Any Door Supervisors operating doors or any other external areas shall at all times wear high visibility jackets / outer clothing.
3. All staff will receive ongoing training in relation to licensing law and practices as well as health and safety law and practice. All training to be kept in form of documented records which shall be made available to Police or local authority officers on request.
- 4 . CCTV to operate within the premises and to cover ANY outside areas. Recordings to be maintained for 21 days. The premises licence holder shall ensure that the DPS or in his/her absence a nominated member of staff is trained in methods of retrieval. Where evidence is requested from the CCTV by a police officer this should be provided for viewing immediately on request, and collection within 24 hours. **\*\* (A maximum period of three months from the granting of any licence should be allowed in order for this condition to be fully complied with)\*\***
5. No persons to be allowed entry to the premises after 03:00 hours. This admission policy will apply to initial entry, thereby allowing persons who have been previously admitted to leave the premises for a short time. The Licence Holder is to ensure the appropriate measures are taken to prevent this condition being breached.
6. The premises licence holder will maintain a stock of polycarbonate or similar non-glass drinking vessels and use the same on a discretionary basis and in conjunction with police advice. Customers will be prevented from removing any drinking vessels / bottles from the premises.
