Rushton and Wilbarston (Pipewell)

The Pipewell Ward, currently in the Parish of Wilbarston be transferred to Rushton Parish Council.	33 responses were received, 23 stating a preference for Option B . Additionally, two petitions were received from Rushton and Pipewell residents with all signatories in favour of Option B . Wilbarston Parish Council favour Option A .
