

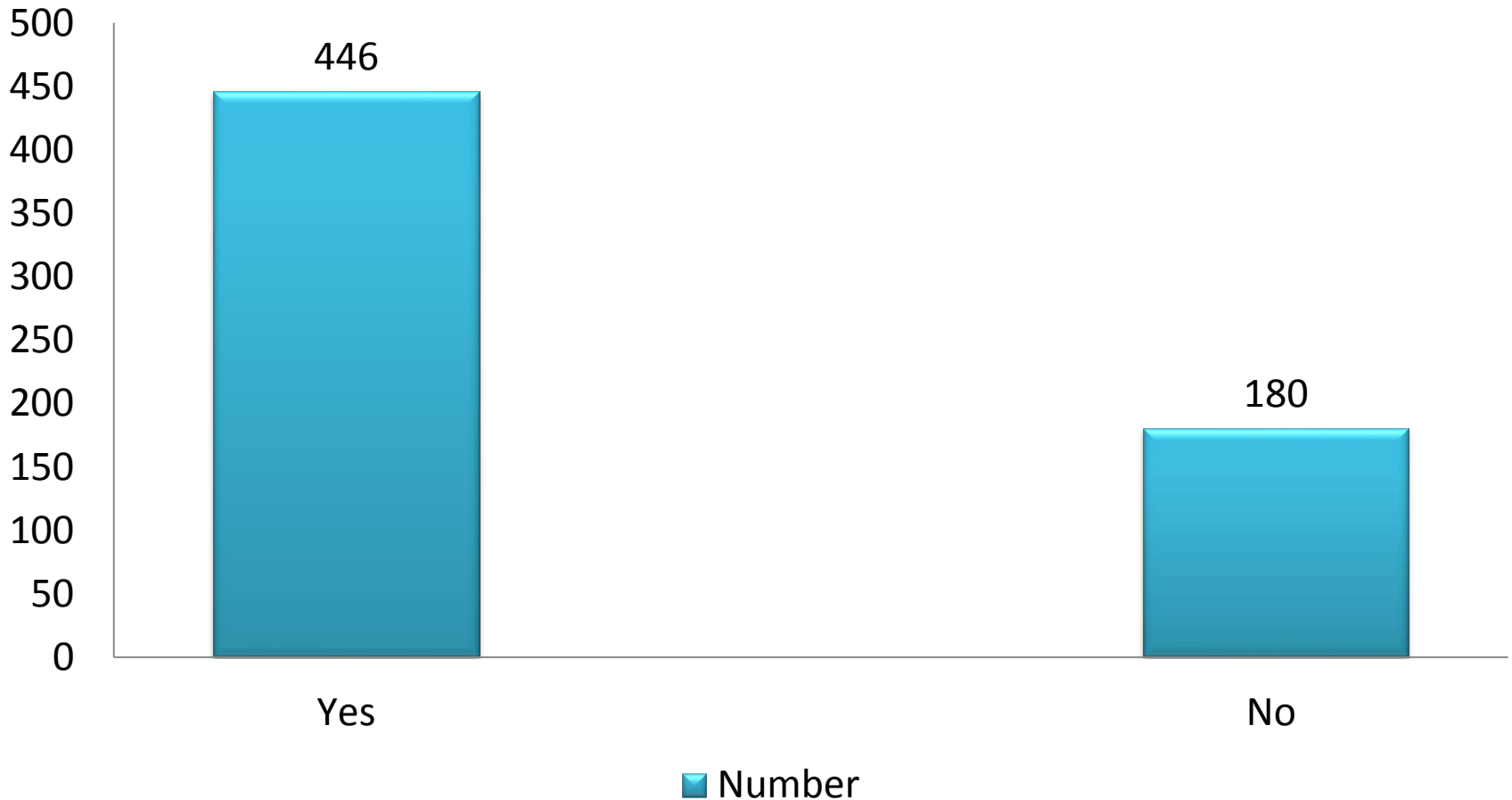
# Public Spaces Protection Order Consultation

## Results of Consultation

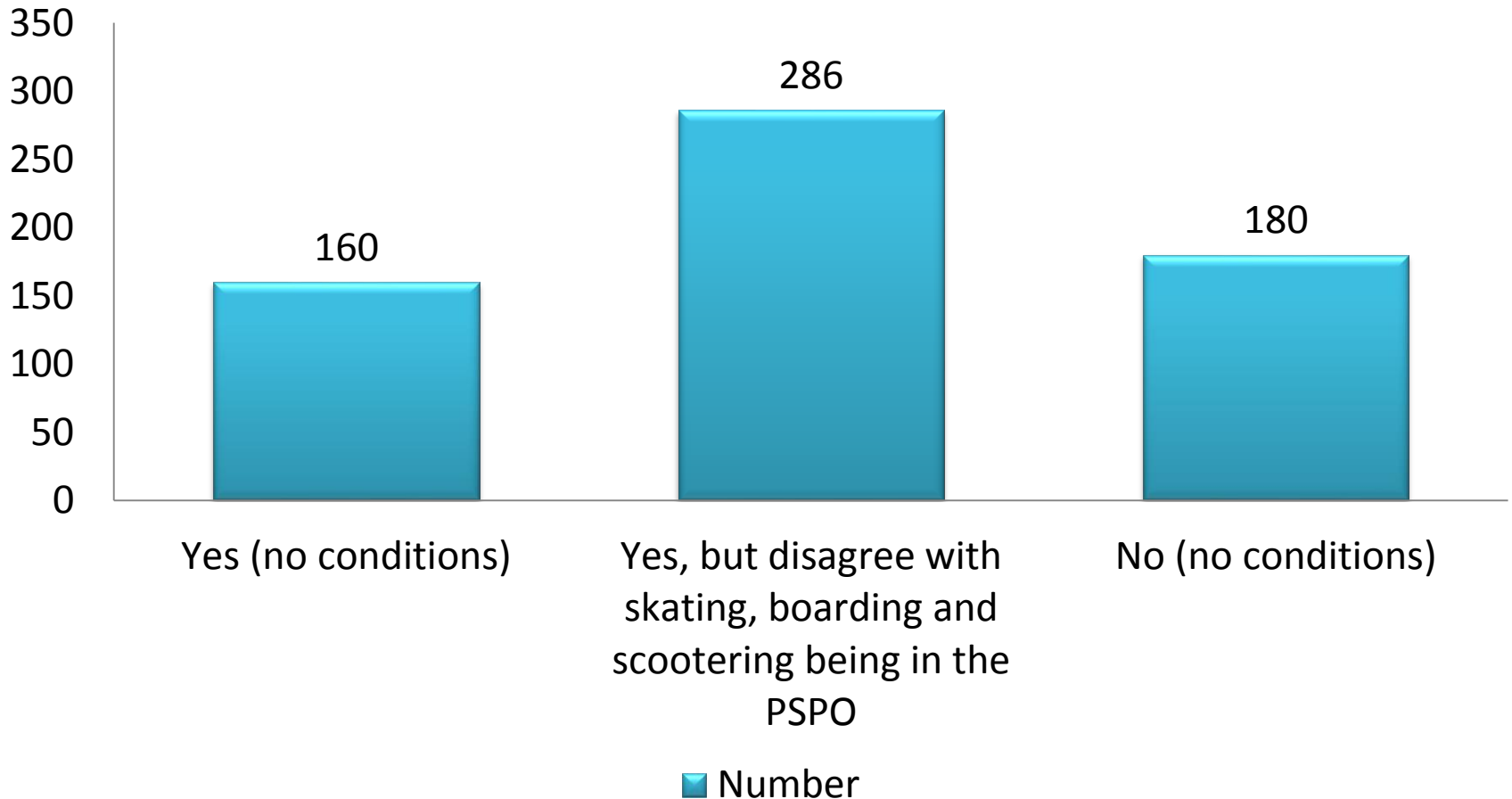
# Results

- 626 Responses in total over 5 months
- 568 Responses via online survey
- 1000 paper copies were sent out in which only 58 Responses were received
- Consultation surveys were delivered to a large number of businesses and properties in and around the PSPO area in Kettering
- Online Petition – submitted as a result of the consultation

# Do you agree with the proposal to have a PSPO in Kettering?



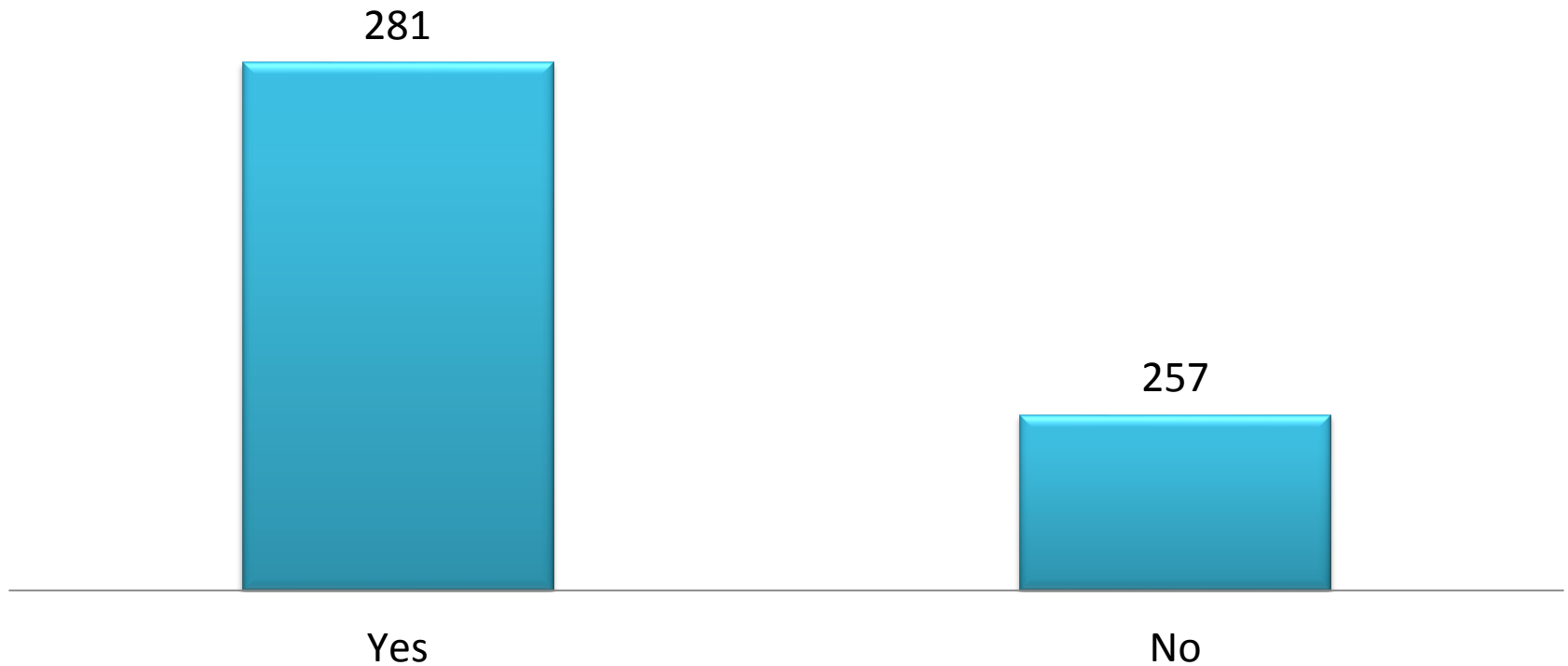
# Do you agree with the proposal to have a PSPO in Kettering?

# Notes

- Begging was raised in terms of the majority of people although not keen on begging were understanding of it and did not want it included in the PSPO. It was seen as criminalising people who had fallen on hard times
- Anti-Social car parking appears massively and appears to be a major issue
- Aggressive/Assertive Charities need to be dealt with
- The so called “Car Club” raises concern
- Teenagers loitering around McDonald's also appears regularly in responses
- “Skateboarding is not a crime” is repeated regularly in response
- Late night drinking also raises concerns with respondents.

## Specific Geographical Issues

- Teenagers Loitering around McDonalds (occasional mention)
- Skateboarding at Morrison's (individual cases)
- Skateboarding at The Market Place (individual cases)
- Anti-Social Parking Market Place and London Road mentioned.
- Late night drinking Rockingham Road Off Licenses (occasional mention)
- Alcohol Abuse at the Rockingham Pleasure Park (individual cases)
- Gatherings “Car Club” at London Road and Dunelm Mill Car Parks (regular mention).
