<p><b>Shopmobility</b></p>	<p>To increase the access of people with permanent and temporary disabilities in Kettering Town centre, through the loan of scooters and wheelchairs to residents of Kettering Borough and people visiting the Borough.</p>	<p><b>£13,000</b></p>
<p><b>Upcycling</b></p>	<p>The provision of upcycling services for furniture and essential household items other than domestic waste within the Borough of Kettering to achieve the following outcomes:-</p> <p>Provide access to affordable, good quality furniture and essential household items for families and individuals in need.</p> <p>Accept and collect donations of furniture and essential household items ready for upcycling where possible.</p> <p>Reduce the amount of waste that is landfilled rather than re-used, upcycled or composted.</p> <p>Provide opportunities for the teaching of basic skills which will assist people to gain confidence in their abilities linking through to better mental health, wellbeing and employment prospects.</p>	<p><b>£20,000</b></p>
