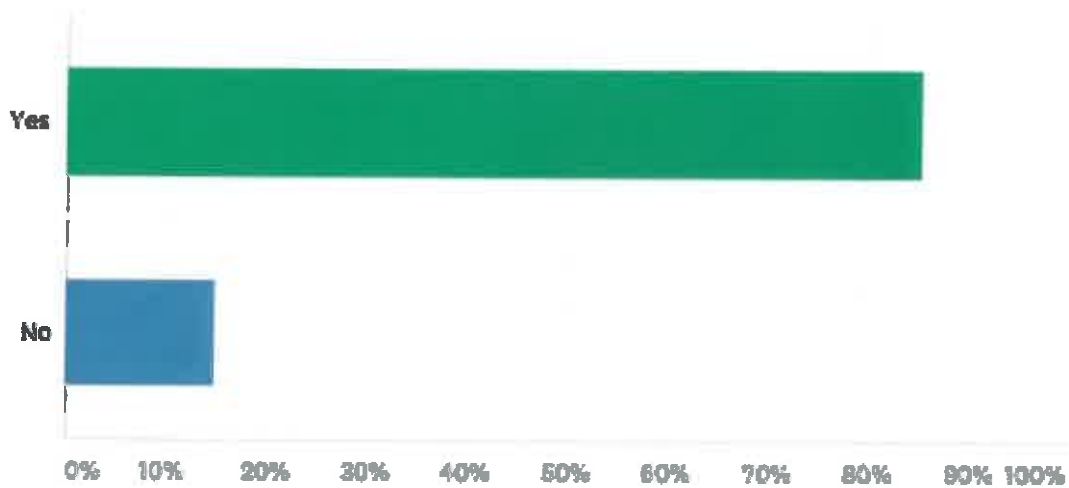

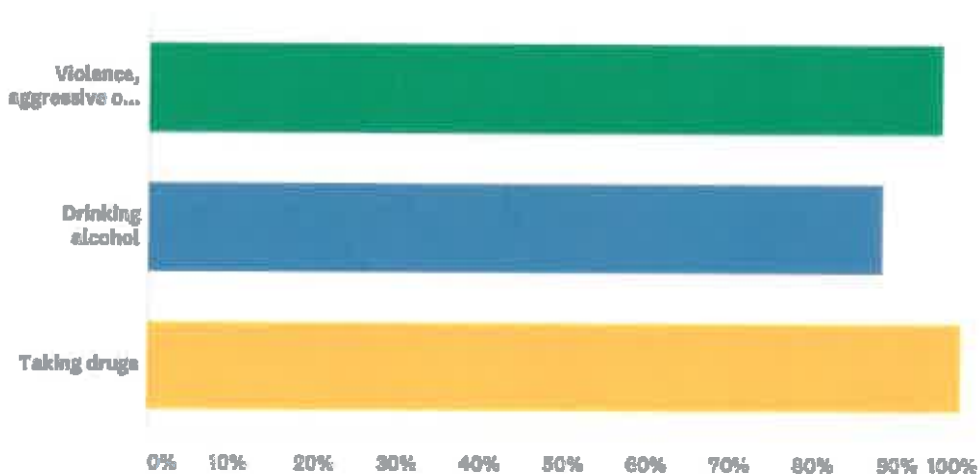
Q1 Do you support the first set of draft Protection Orders?

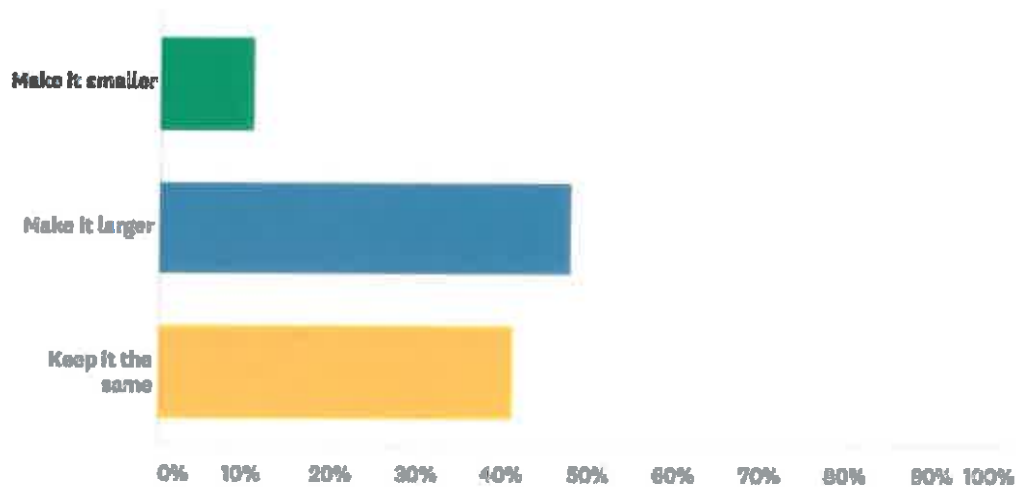
Q2 Do you agree that the issues listed below should be covered by the Protection Order? (please tick all that apply)

Public Space Protection Orders were created by the 2014, Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act to deal with any nuisance or problems in a particular area that affect the local community's quality of life. A PSPO imposes conditions on how an area can be used, with the aim of preventing anti-social behaviour in public spaces.
