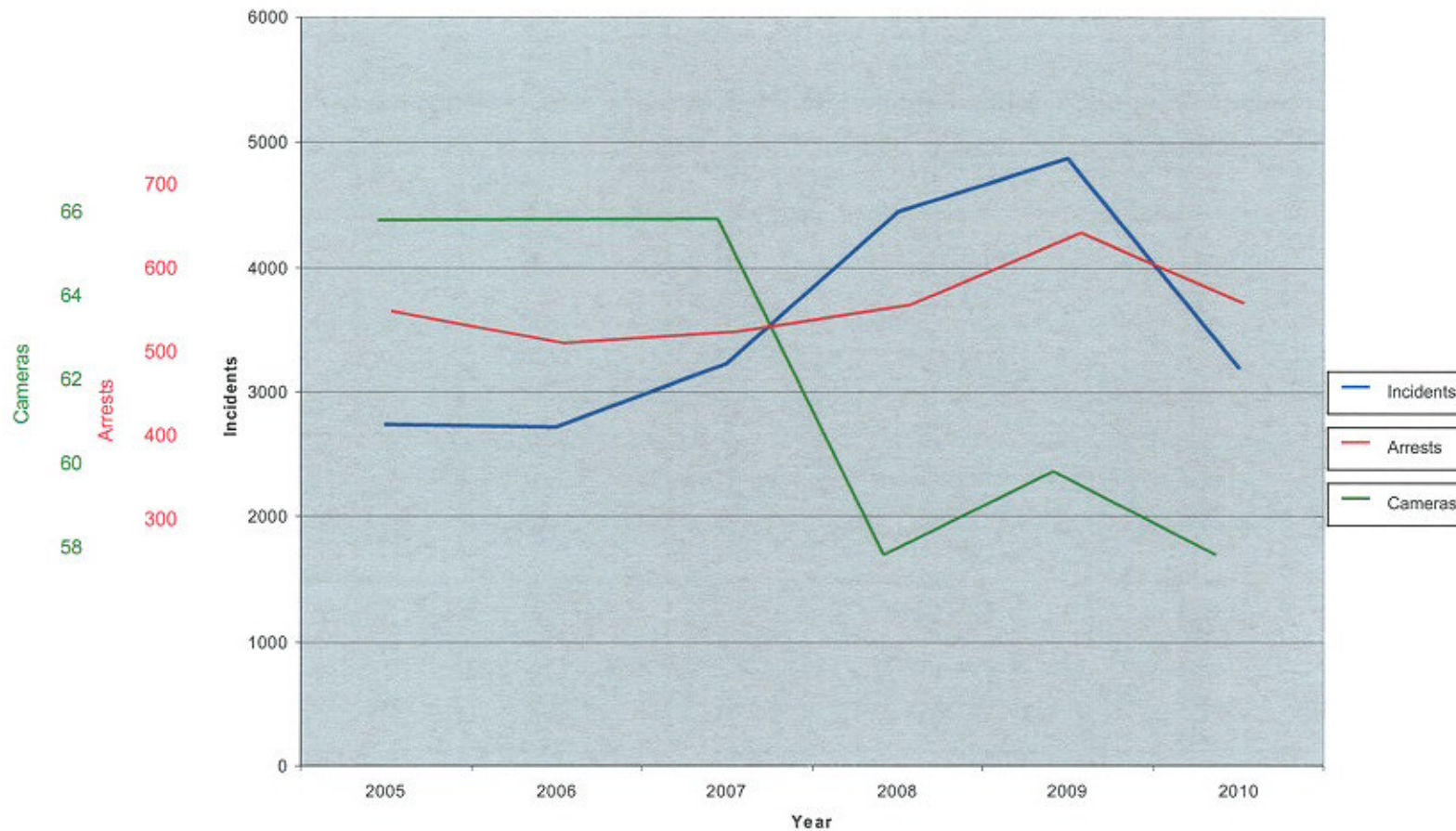
KEY OBJECTIVES OF THE CCTV SYSTEM
